Welcome to the 2023 Auction!

We've Rolled Out the **Red** Carpet for YOU, our friends and donors, that have made so much possible for our members over the last few years. The Auction looks and feels a little different with a new theme, venue and date, but we're proud that it's still the biggest and best Auction in town! I hope you and your guests have a wonderful evening touring the beautiful Brady Family Clubhouse, reconnecting with old friends and of course, bidding on unique items to raise funds for the kids in East County.

It's been a while since we've seen many of you, so I thought I'd give a little update on the Clubs since COVID. The Clubs have proven our resilience and are thriving due to the care and concern of our beloved donors, board members (both operating and foundation) and dedicated staff. During the height of the pandemic in the Fall of 2020, kids across the nation started their school year in distance-learning. Concerned our members would not have the support they needed if they were home alone while their parents were essential workers, or home while their parents worked from home, we opened 'distance-learning camps' at our Santee and La Mesa Clubhouses. This meant, for an incredibly nominal fee, members could have access to the Club Monday- Friday from 8am-6pm to do their school classes on Zoom, complete homework, safely interact with peers, eat 3 meals daily and have access to high-speed internet. Many of you donated to the Fund for Families in Need, this heavily subsidized the cost we incurred running these camps, so we wouldn't have to charge families even a fraction of the cost. Throughout the pandemic, our kids showed resilience to the changes happening all around them and in their lives. Thanks for helping provide an ounce of normalcy, safety, food security and a sense of belonging to the kids during that time. We continue to help children work through distancelearning loss and aim to build their confidence so they can grow into productive, caring and responsible citizens.

Thanks again for being here tonight, I hope we are making you proud by providing the best after-school care for local children that need us most.

Someone you know relies on the Boys & Girls Clubs of East County.

We aren't a daycare or a rec-center, we like to think of ourselves as the modern version of playing outside! The Clubs provide after school activities, mentorship, programs and meals to kids ages 6-18 years old, Monday through Friday from 2-6pm during the school year, school bus transportation from local public schools to our Clubs (where available) and summer camp, Monday through Friday 8am-6pm.

The Club isn't just for children and families struggling to make ends meet; it is our intention to be available to serve any kids in community that need us. We take pride in bridging the gap between school and home for hundreds of local girls and boys every year. We aren't just clean Clubhouses with food, high-speed internet, fun activities and friends. Our stellar staff help kids develop their self-confidence and create positive self-image through goal setting, introducing them to new activities and being a positive role model. Our programs are designed to augment what members are learning in school, while encouraging them to develop their own opinions and critical-thinking skills. Our facilities were a haven for hundreds during COVID and distance-learning, and are environments conducive to completing homework, movement and structure with creativity.





Our members have different backgrounds, needs and strengths; and they are all worthy of the tools needed to build an awesome life for themselves. We expect our members to go above-and-beyond for their community and families, and we teach them how to be problem-solvers, critical-thinkers and homework doers (sometimes reluctantly!).

The Clubs don't disqualify any child from becoming a member due to inability to pay the fees we charge. It is through the generosity and kindness from friends like you and events like this one that allow us to heavily subsidize the cost of our services for East County's families.

Rules of the Auction

SILENT AUCTION BIDDING

An auction participant will place a bid using the bid stickers provided. The person with the highest bid at the time of closing will be considered the winner. Stickers placed after the closing of the silent auction will be considered null and void. Once the sticker is placed on a bid sheet it cannot be removed for any reason. Stickers placed on bid sheets are a legal contract to purchase the item.

All items are offered "AS IS." The event organization shall not be responsible for the accuracy of descriptions, genuineness, authorship or condition of items. You MAY NOT pay for OR take possession of an item you did not win. Once an item is paid for and is in your possession, the organization is no longer responsible if it lost, stolen or broken.

Items, including gift certificates, may not be redeemed for cash and expiration dates may not be extended. Note that goods, services and travel packages have various expiration dates specified by the donor and are subject to availability. If an expiration date is not listed, it will be valid for one year from event date. Most travel packages have blackout dates specified by the donor. Air transportation IS NOT included in a trip package unless specified.

GUARANTEED MAXIMUM PURCHASE PRICE

Some silent items offer a guaranteed maximum purchase price. Bidding will stop once the guaranteed maximum is met. Some selected silent items offer multiple items at an established price for purchases (no incremental bidding.)

PREMIUM SILENT AUCTION

There is no bidding on premium silent auction items since an established price will be charged. Multiple items are available for these select items.

LIVE AUCTION BIDDING

The live auction will take place on stage or a designated area at a specified time. A bid acknowledged by the auctioneer is a legal contract to purchase the item. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer or official staff shall be the purchaser. Every effort will be made to identify and recognize all bids, but it is your responsibility as a bidder to make your bid known. In the event of a question as to the validity of any bid, the event staff will have final discretion to either determine the successful bidder, or to re-offer the item for the auction. A minimum raise required of at least \$100 higher than the existing bid for all live bidding. The auctioneer, at his sole discretion, can alter raises for any item.

BIDDING DISCLOSURE

Suggested retail values are only a guide. There are no minimum bids required to purchase any items other than the minimum raises in the silent auction, and the established prices for items in the Multiple Silent Auction and Premium Silent Auction sections. Participants at the event will determine the real value of each item through the bidding. All sales are final and there will be no exchanges, refunds or substitutions.

SUGGESTED RETAIL VALUE FOR TRAVEL & HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Airlines: Tariff rates are utilized. One-way fares are utilized if two different cities are featured on the departing and returning flights.

Hotels and Tours: Hotels are valued at rack rate plus sales tax. The rack rate for a hotel is the published full price for which hotel rooms are sold and is not necessarily indicative of the current market rate.

Cruises: Brochure rate for the cabin plus airfare add-ons offered by the cruise line in the brochure.

Ground Transportation: Unless specifically stated otherwise, no ground transportation is included in any package. The winning bidders are required to secure and pay for ground transportation from airports to hotels, airports to cruise ships, hotels to included attractions or tours, etc.

All reservations are subject to availability. Please review text and materials for all restrictions and expiration dates. Blackout dates and holiday restrictions may apply. Rates are based on the high season that the gift certificate is eligible for redemption.

CASHIERING CHECK OUT

Cashiering for live items will be conducted at your dinner tables at the time of the live auction. Silent items will be available for pickup in the lobby at approximately 9:00pm. We accept cash, checks, American Express, Visa, or Mastercard, for your purchases and highly encourage everyone to provide a credit card at check-in. If you need to leave prior to invoices being completed, please call the non-profit to arrange to pick up your items post-event.

TAX DEDUCTABILITY

According to IRS Rules and Regulations, the only tax deduction for the purchase of auction items from non-profit organizations is the amount paid in excess of fair market value. We suggest that you contact your tax professional to determine the tax deductions (if any) for your specific purchase(s).

BID BY PROXY

Bid by Proxy will take place with the participant completely filling out the Bid by Proxy form on the event auction website. Incomplete and/or illegible forms will be considered null and void. A representative will place the proxy amount at the start of the auction unless it is for the Guaranteed Maximum Purchase Price. If the bid is for a Guaranteed Maximum Purchase item, the bid will be placed 30 minutes after the start of the auction provided that the item has not been purchased by another attendee at the event. The delay of placing the proxy bid provides attending guests an opportunity to bid on all auction items.

AIRFARE UPGRADES

The airfare upgrade in the program is based on a two-category plane (coach class and first class). If a plane with three categories (coach, business and first class) is utilized for the flight, the upgrade will be to the next highest level of service.
