




Who we Serve

Based on our 2024 Annual Report

- 1,073 Members ages 6-18
- 91% qualify for free or reduced lunch at their local public school
- 15% are military connected
- 31% are being raised in single-parent households



The Boys & Girls Clubs of East County have been developing, implementing, and providing activities and programs to youth who need us most since 1961. Operating in the communities of El Cajon, Lakeside, La Mesa and Santee, the Clubs offer four full –service clubhouses with gymnasiums for children 6-18, and a Teen Center in La Mesa designated for teens ages 12-18. Our ultimate goal has been to provide children with age-appropriate activities, trained professional staff, STEM Labs, clean, well maintained buildings and a safe, healthy atmosphere.






Our Financials
